

Waste plant snag

The city administration's project to construct a garbage station in Bang Sue District has hit a snag after failing to receive consent from the City Council.

The council wants it to go somewhere else. The 628-million-baht project was to go close to the Rama VI Bridge on the Bangkok side. Up to 2,000 tonnes of garbage would be loaded and packed into cubes before being sent by train to a sanitary landfill.

Mr Somphong and local people said it was too close to homes, temples and schools.
